DECISION N° _____/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC OF _____

Organising the competitive examination into the **Third Year of the Design Engineering training Cycle (03 years)** of the School of Chemical Engineering and Mineral Industries (EGCIM) of the University of Ngaoundere, and fixing the number of places stipulated in the **2023/2024** academic year.

Mindful of the Decree N°2005/142 of 29 April 2005 organising the Ministry of Higher Education;
Mindful of the Order N°92/074 of 13 April 1992 transforming the University Centres of Buea and of Ngaoundere into Universities;
Mindful of the Order N°93/027 of 19 January 1993, defining provisions common to all Universities;
Mindful of the Decree N°2005/342 of 10 September 2005 to modify and complete certain dispositions of the decree N°93/027 of 19 January 1993, defining provisions common to all Universities;
Mindful of the Order N°93/026 of 19 January 1993, creating Universities;
Mindful of the Order N°93/028 of 19 January 1993 fixing the administrative and academic organisation of the University of Ngaoundere;
Mindful of the Order N°93/032 of 19 January 1993 fixing the financial regulations applicable to Universities;
Mindful of the Decree N°2005/383 of 17 October 2005 fixing the financial regulations applicable to Universities;
Mindful of the Order N°99/003 of 19 January 1993, modifying certain provisions of Decree N°79/186 of 17 May 1979 stating the amount payable as tuition fee;
Mindful of the Decree N°2017/402 of 27 June 2017, appointing the Rector of the University of Ngaoundere;
Mindful of the Order N°2017/585 of 24 November 2017 stating the administrative and academic organization of the School of Chemical Engineering and Mineral Industries (EGCIM) of the University of Ngaoundere ;

On the proposition of the Rector of the University of Ngaoundere;

DECIDES:

Article 1: A Competitive entrance through written examination for admission of **sixty (60)** students into the **third year of the Design Engineering training Cycle (03 years)** in the following Training programs: **Process Engineering and Fine Chemistry, Chemical Industries Engineering, Mineral Engineering, Material Engineering, Control and Instrumentation**

Engineering and Electromechanical Engineering of the School of Chemical Engineering and Mineral Industries (EGCIM) of the University of Ngaoundere for the **2023/2024** academic year shall take place on **Saturday 05th August 2023**.

Article 2: (1) The entrance Examination mentioned in Article 1 above is open to Cameroonians of both sexes as well as to foreigners resident in Cameroon;

(2) Cameroonians and foreigners may be admitted through the study of the application files. Nevertheless, the number of places for admission through the study of application files shall not exceed **10% of the total number of places available**;

Article 3: The Candidates for the entrance examination should be holders of one of the following qualifications:

- A Bachelor of Science or Technology;
- The University Diploma of Technology equivalent to the field of studies solicited;
- Any other diploma or equivalent qualification related to the program that is recognized by the Ministry of Higher Education.

Article 4: The complete application file should comprise the following documents:

- 1) A registration form filled by the candidate bearing a fiscal stamp of 1500 FCFA to be downloaded from the website: www.concours-egcim.cm;
- 2) A certified true copy of the Birth certificate dated not more than three (03) months old;
- 3) A certified true copy of the required diplomas/certificates for the exam;
- 4) 04 recent passport- size photographs (4x4) ;
- 5) A medical certificate delivered by a government owned medical doctor dated not more than three (03) months;
- 6) A receipt of payment of the sum of twenty thousand (**20 000**) FCFA representing the examination fee to the “**EGCIM de NGAOUNDERE**” account, delivered by the: **SOCIETE GENERALE CAMEROUN**, bank Code: 10003, Counter Code: 00900, bank account N°: **22090795734**, RIB/code: 19. Deposit may also be done directly in any agency of the **SOCIETE GENERALE CAMEROUN** bank or via a partner of the University of Ngaoundere notably MTN.
- 7) An A4 sized self-addressed and 1500 FCFA stamped envelop.

Article 5: Complete files should be deposited on or before **Thursday 03rd August 2023** at any of the following places:

- The Ministry of Higher Education/Directorate of Development of Higher Education at the 13th Floor,
- Directorate of EGCIM of the University of Ngaoundere;
- The Branch of the University of Ngaoundere in Yaoundé, “Quartier Fouda”;

- Any of the Regional Delegations of the Ministry of Secondary Education (MINESEC) for Bafoussam, Bamenda, Bertoua, Buea, Douala, Ebolowa, Garoua, Maroua, Ngaoundéré, Yaoundé.

Article 6: The Entrance examination is based on written tests on the following subjects:

Article 7: The written part of the Entrance examination into the Third Year of the School of Chemical Engineering and Mineral Industries (EGCIM) of the University of Ngaoundere will take place in examination centres in Bafoussam, Bamenda, Bertoua, Buea, Douala, Ebolowa, Garoua, Maroua, Ngaoundéré, Yaoundé.

Article 8: The written tests shall take place on Saturday 05th August 2023 at the Centres as indicated in article 7.

Article 9: A communique from the Rector of the University of Ngaoundere shall precise modalities and venue for each examination Centre, as well as plan for the written tests.

Article 10: Candidates are required to present themselves at the examination Centres at least one hour before the start of the exams. They must come along with their National Identity Card or any other authentic identification document.

Article 11: The Rector of the University of Ngaoundere, the Director of the Department of University Accreditations and Quality, and the Director of EGCIM Ngaoundere, are each in their own capacity, responsible for the execution of this decision, which shall be registered and published in French and English everywhere where need be.
